Stanley Bruneau was the only athlete representing Tahiti accompanied by his President Christian Pothier of the Tahiti Bodybuilding and Physique Sports

Federation to Bangkok, Thailand for the Men's World Athletic Physique competition.



Earlier in the month of November 2012 he participated in the 19th South Pacific Bodybuilding Championships and won the overall title in bodybuilding at Rarotonga – Cook Islands. Immediately after winning the South Pacific title, he switched to Men's Athletic Physique as his body structure was more suitable to this category; He was well prepared and ready to take on the elite athletes of the world.



Stanley is the first Tahitian to win a Bronze Medal in the Men's Athletic Physique under 180 cm. for his country in Bangkok, Thailand in the World Championships. He was very pleased and proud to achieve this result, and his next aim is to win the Gold Medal in the South Pacific Championships in Tonga in 2013. By profession, Stanley is a Senior Police Officer in Tahiti, and he was born in Toulon, France on 26th September 1980. He was training bodybuilding for the past 7 years and his main dream is to win the World Championships Gold Medal for his beloved country in Budapest, Hungary in November 2013.
